

**Canadian Resident Match - Gynecologic Oncology Fellowship Positions for Academic
Year starting July 1, 2021**

The Gynecologic Oncology Fellowship Programs across the country will hold a Match. Only Canadian residents who are in Canadian residency programs will be eligible for this Match. If you are applying as a non-Canadian, or attending a residency program outside of Canada, please contact your program of interest as to the process for acceptance. The process and timelines for the match for Gyn Oncology Fellowship positions for the academic year starting July 1st 2021 is as follows:

Please apply to the programs that you wish to attend and complete their interview and selection processes.

1. **15 October 2020:** Notify programs if you are withdrawing from the Canadian Match.
2. **19 October 2020 at 6pm EST:** deadline for each applicant to e-mail their ranking for each program where they interviewed. Candidates are to email their rankings to the Chair of the RCPSC Gyn Onc Specialty Committee, Dr. Lilian Gien, at lilian.gien@sunnybrook.ca. Please title the e-mail **"Gyn Onc Match 2021 Rankings"**
3. **19 October 2020 at 6pm EST:** deadline for each Program Director to email to Dr. Lilian Gien at lilian.gien@sunnybrook.ca:
 - The number of funded positions for FRCS(C) Canadian candidates.
 - List of applicant(s) with their rankings. Also contact information for each candidate.

Residents will be assigned positions based on their preferred rankings and the availability of positions at the universities they applied.

4. **23 October 2020:** Letter of offer of admission to be sent to candidates by each Program. You will be contacted directly by the Program indicating whether you have been successful in your match requests. You will also be notified if you have not been successful in your match requests and where there may be openings available.
5. **26 October 2020 at 12 noon EST:** Deadline for candidates to accept or decline the offer of admission.
